Content Guidelines

Nonfiction essays up to 800 words max will be eligible with sentiments that reflect the importance of nondiscrimination. This includes sexual orientation, gender, race, or any other form of discrimination and bigotry.

Entries will be judged equally on excellence of writing and the ability to effectively communicate the theme of nondiscrimination. Raving Dove's editor and board of directors will serve as judges.

Submission Period and Announcement of Winners

Entries will be accepted between October 1, 2009, and November 30, 2009.

Winners will be announced at Raving Dove's Web site on December 31, 2009.

Essays will be presented at this time.
